All trees on the site will be mulched on the site and retained on site for mulching the new garden landscaped areas.

## **Building Waste**

Building waste will consist of packaging waste and building offcuts.

- $1 \times 14$  cubic metre skip will be on the site where building offcuts that can be recycled will be disposed off. This bin will be collected as necessary and taken to a building waste recycling facility and if necessary replaced as the last skip is collected.
- 1x10 cubic metre general waste skip any non recyclable packaging or building consumable waste will be placed in the general waste skip. It will be removed and taken to a licensed waste landfill site. A clean skip bin will replace the skip removed.

No excavated material will be removed from the Site.
