Purpose of this application form:

This application form should be completed by an executor or other authorised person (for example the beneficiary) that seeks to transfer an interment right from the holder (deceased) to a new holder.

A cemetery operator may transfer an interment right from one person or two or more persons as joint holders to one person or two or more persons as joint holders. A person to whom an interment right devolves does not become the holder of the interment right until the cemetery operator's register is amended.

Form approved by Cemeteries & Crematoria NSW under subsection 58(3) of the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013.*

This application form is not required for transferring rights between joint holders. On the death of a joint holder of an interment right, the remaining joint holder/s is/are entitled to the interment right. Surviving joint holder/s should advise the cemetery operator of the death of one joint holder so the cemetery operator's register can be updated.
