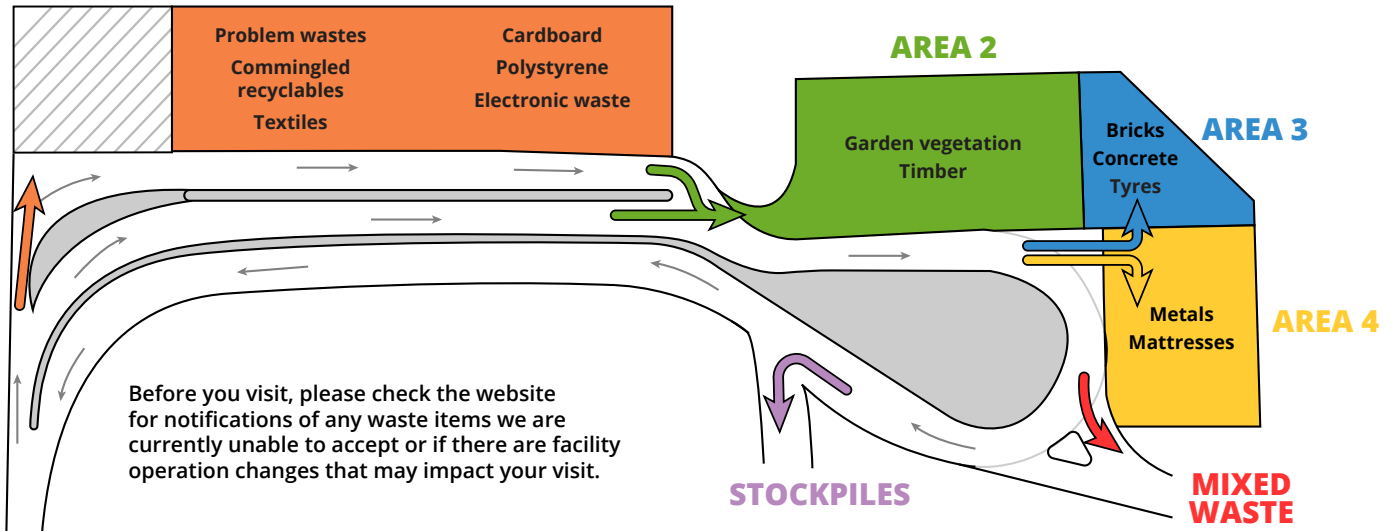
## **Maitland Resource Recovery Facility**

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU VISIT**

Maitland Resource Recovery Facility (MRRF) is undergoing a major transformation with a renewed focus on resource recovery and circular economy.

To help us achieve this goal, we need your help. Inside, you'll discover practical tips to save money and recycle more, like sorting your waste before leaving home or arranging a bulky waste service.

## AREA 1 Community Recycling Centres



### SORT YOUR LOAD AND SAVE MONEY

By sorting your load and using the Community Recycling Centre (CRC) and other areas, you'll save money and help us keep items out of landfill.

**Step 1:** Before you leave home, identify whether you have any recyclable items in your load that can be dropped off at areas 1 to 4.

**Step 2:** Neatly and securely pack your trailer, grouping your waste together so it's easier to unload later. Remember, pack in reverse order so that items that can be dropped off first are packed last. Use the map above to plan your trip around the facility.

**Step 3:** After visiting the recycling areas, return to the weighbridge to reweigh. If you don't, you'll be charged the mixed waste rate for the entire trailer.

**Step 4:** Dispose of any mixed waste remaining in landfill.

### BULKY WASTE SERVICE

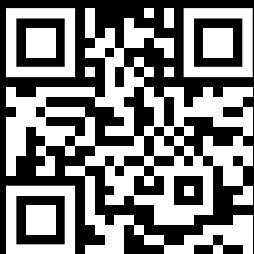
Each household in Maitland receives two waste services each financial year, to dispose of bulky household items.

By visiting Council's website, you can redeem two 250kg digital waste vouchers, which permit you to drop bulky waste at the MRRF for free, two kerbside bulky waste pickups from your place of residence or a mix of one of each.

Please be mindful and separate your recyclables when using waste vouchers, so they don't go to landfill.
