- 6 Native feature tree planting to median strip.
- 7 Display home to Architectural documentation.

Notes

- 1 Boundary fencing with timber sleeper bollard style to main entry from carpark, with sliding access gate.
- 2 Paved link to carpark with contrasting bands, sculptural elements, and feature planting.
- 3 Large, decked area with pergola over, providing outdoor gathering space with table and chairs, feature pots with architectural planting.
- 4 Feature paving with connection between outdoor areas.
- 5 Explorative pathway with access to a variety of small open spaces, sculptural elements, firepit and feature planting.
- 6 Large feature trees to provide outlook from display home.
- 7 Narrow feature trees to reinforce precinct entry features.
- 8 Placemaking signage walls as continuation of main estate entry feature. Refer L403.
- 9 Stepping stone sleeper pavers in planting to provide contrasting, informal access path.
- 10 Trees and mass planting to fence line, displaying a variety of low maintenance, predominantly native planting.

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
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
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
