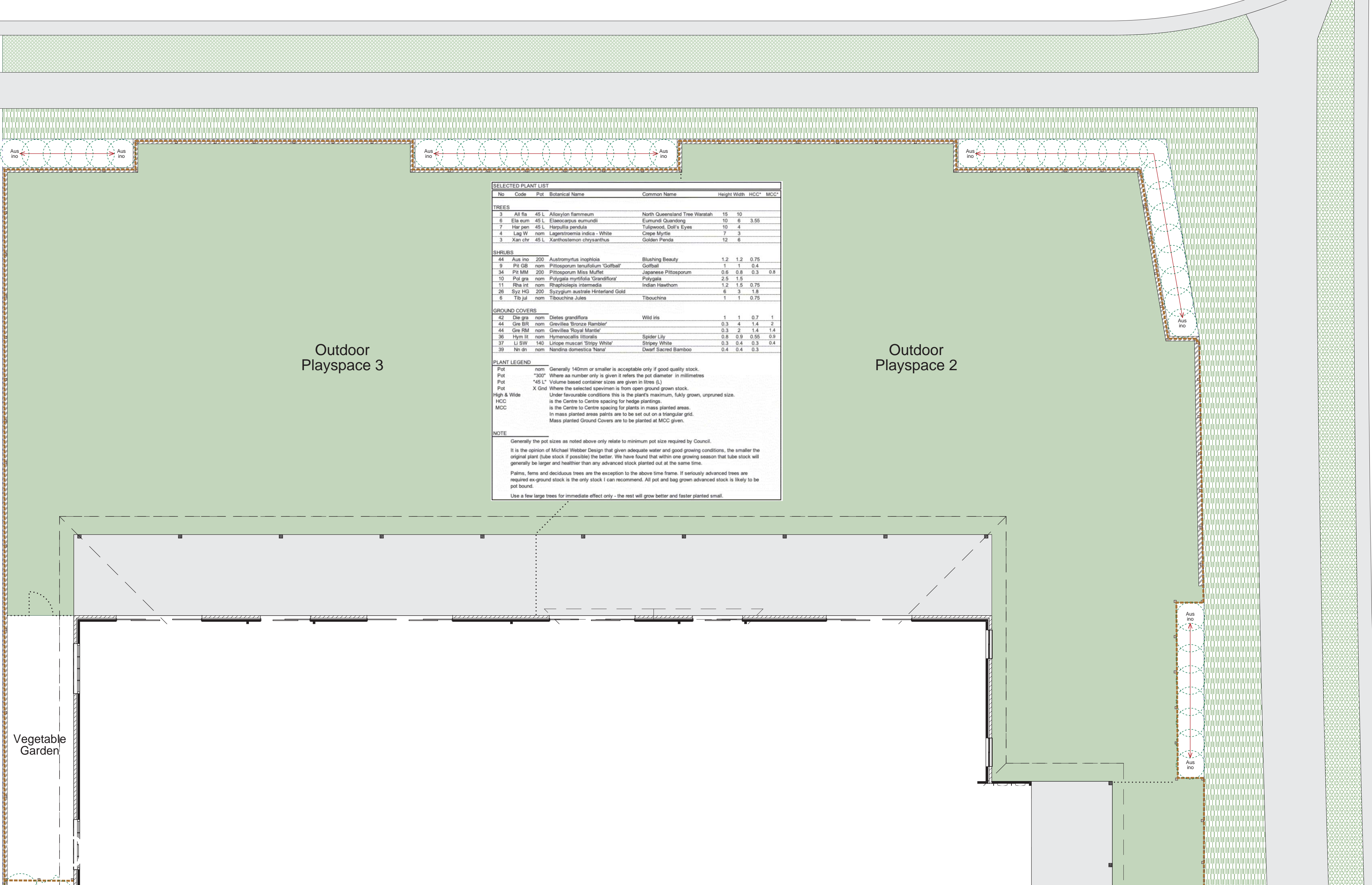

PLANT LEGEND								
Pot	nom	Generally 140mm or smaller is acceptable only if good quality stock.						
Pot	"300"	Where a number only is given it refers to the pot diameter in millimetres						
Pot	"45 L"	Volume based container sizes are given in litres (L)						
Pot	X Gnd	Where the selected specimen is from open ground grown stock.						
High & Wide	Under favourable conditions this is the plant's maximum, fully grown, unpruned size.							
HCC	is the Centre to Centre spacing for hedge plantings.							
MCC	is the Centre to Centre spacing for plants in mass planted areas.							
	In mass planted areas plants are to be set out on a triangular grid.							
	Mass planted Ground Covers are to be planted at MCC given.							
NOTE								
Generally the pot sizes as noted above only relate to minimum pot size required by Council.								
It is the opinion of Michael Webber Design that given adequate water and good growing conditions, the smaller the original plant (tube stock if possible) the better. We have found that within one growing season that tube stock will generally be larger and healthier than any advanced stock planted out at the same time.								
Palms, ferns and deciduous trees are the exception to the above time frame. If seriously advanced trees are required ex-ground stock is the only stock I can recommend. All pot and bag grown advanced stock is likely to be pot bound.								
Use a few large trees for immediate effect only - the rest will grow better and faster planted small.
